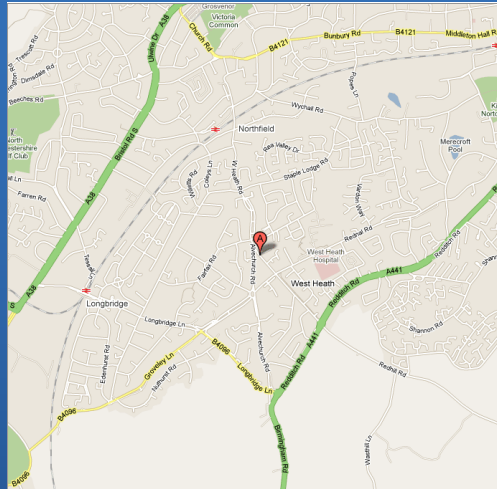


Orthodontics

We specialise in the treatment of children and all children are routinely assessed for orthodontic need. In addition many of our patients are being treated on referral from other Dental Surgeons. We are able to provide simple and complex orthodontic treatment (tooth straightening).

Both Dr Wayne Addison and Mrs Catherine Addison have formal Orthodontic training and hold Specialist qualifications. They are on the Specialist List of the General Dental Council and have practised orthodontics for 30 years. The practice holds a contract for the provision of NHS Orthodontic treatment for children who are under 18 years of age at the commencement of treatment. Adult patients may be treated under private contract.
